Instructions:

This is a 2 pocket, self correcting activity.

To make the pockets:

Fold the bottom of the cover up towards the back (about 3" from the bottom) so that the picture and the words Nebuchadnezzar's Dreams are on the front and the titles -- The Tree and The Statue -- are on the back. Fold in half to make a "book" with folded up part inside. With white glue, glue 3 thin strips -- one up each side and one up the middle -- to form 2 pockets.

To make the cards:

The statue pictures should be printed back to back with the words that describe the statue (pages 2 and 3). The tree pictures should be printed back to back with the words that describe the tree dream (pages 4 and 5). These are best printed on card stock so the ink will not show through to the words side. Cut the tree and statue pictures apart. Cut each picture into strips with one description on each strip. Put all the strips for a tree and all the strips for a statue in one of the pockets.

How to use pocket activity:

Pass out the pocket activities (cards inside) to each child. Let the children read each card and decide which dream it describes. Then, he can put the card in the correct pocket. After sorting all the cards into their correct pocket, the child can then turn the cards over and complete the picture/puzzle. If they got the cards in the correct pocket, they should have a complete picture of a tree and a statue like Nebuchadnezzar dreamed about.
